## **Graffiti/Wall Art Assignment Sheet**

With this assignment, you will be showing how **you** are an *individual in society*. It will go along with and help you to better understand this year's theme for our literature study.

To do the assignment, each of you will be creating a piece of wall art that will look like graffiti but will not be directly drawn on the wall. With all of the cluster's graffiti we will be decorating the wall. Real graffiti is usually drawings or inscriptions that are made on public surfaces such as walls or rocks. Ours will drawn on paper and then attached to a surface.

## **Directions:**

**First**, draw your first (or last) initial on a large sheet of paper. Make the letter in a way so the symbols may be drawn inside the letter or as part of the letter.

Add five symbols that show ways in which you are an **individual** and another five that show societies of which you are a part. Remember, in illustrating how you are an individual, you show the things that make you different from others. You may include your personality, your likes/dislikes, your talents, etc. Societies, on the other hand, are groups you have joined for the same purpose. Incorporate your first and last name into your drawing.

Make your initial attractive with color, drawings, clip art or clippings from magazines.

When your graffiti is complete, be prepared to show it to the rest of the class.

**Finally**, you will write a well-structured paragraph to explain your initial. It will tell why you have included your symbols and how each represents you as an individual or you in a society.
